Easter egg decorating

Ages 4-6





- Eggs
- Tissue paper
- ▶ Glue
- Paint brush

Instructions

- 1. Get an adult to prick a hole in your egg. Empty out the insides into a bowl.
- 2. Tear bits of coloured tissue paper into pieces.
- 3. Using glue stick them onto the egg to create a colourful masterpiece!

N.B. This can get a bit messy & sticky! All part of the fun though!



Easter egg decorating

Ages 7-9





You will need

- Eggs
- Stickers
- Paint
- Paint brush
- Sellotape/masking tape

Instructions

- 1. Get an adult to prick a hole in your egg. Empty out the insides into a bowl.
- 2. Using any stickers you may have, stars, spots, triangles... stick them on the egg or use tape to add stripes.
- 4. Paint your egg and leave to dry.
- 5. Peel off the stickers and tape.
- 6. This will leave a lovely pattern on your egg!

Easter egg decorating

Ages 10-12





You will need

- Eggs
- Paint
- Black felt tip
- Paint brush
- Anything you have for accessories

Instructions

- 1. Prick a hole in your egg and empty out the insides into a bowl.
- 2. Paint your egg and leave to dry.
- 3. Use a felt tip pen to add a funny face.
- 4. Use tissue paper, buttons, fabric, anything you may have at home to add some more detail for hair, make a hat, ears, fabric for clothes...
- 5. Or cut the top off and grow cress for hair!
